MODERN/JAZZ DANCE CLASSES

These are held on Saturday afternoons at the theatre. There are two sessions, Juniors and Seniors, with a lower age limit of 7 years. Classes are taken by Helena Barnard and although ballet training is helpful, classes are also suitable for beginners.

THE CHORUS LINE

Our drama/musical theatre group meets on Tuesdays at the theatre from 5- 6 pm. The lower age limit for this group is 7 years.

STREET/HIP HOP CLASSES

BOYS CLASSES

A "Boys only" ballet class is held on Tuesday nights for age 6 years and above. Younger boys are catered for in the normal Saturday classes.

VOCATIONAL TRAINING

Students who would like to train professionally need to be aware that this is very demanding and the standard of professional dancers is higher than ever before. To have a chance of auditioning successfully for a full time dance school, students need to be taking a minimum of 3 ballet classes per week and we offer a Vocational class on Fridays taught by Katy Sinnadurai to those senior students who have both the physical attributes necessary to be a dancer and the desire to train for this. This class is by invitation only.

JUNIOR TECHNIQUE CLASS

This class is for pupils in Grades 2 and 3 and will focus on basic technique and strengthening including some pilates exercises to further enhance the pupils' performance. The class will be offered to pupils who have begun to show enthusiasm and a natural aptitude towards dance, either through ballet, musicality or performance and is by invitation only.

ADULT BALLET/PILATES CLASSES are run on Tuesday evenings at Priory School from 6.15 - 7.15 This is a mixed ability class and beginners are welcome. Please contact us for details.
